Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund -ARPA

On September 29, the U.S. Department of the Treasury announced the release of [Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund \(LATCF\)](#) payments to counties. The LATCF provides \$1.5 billion in two equal payments of \$750 million for FYs 2022 and 2023 to "eligible revenue sharing counties" under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). NACO has worked with Congress and the administration since March 2021 to ensure the final distribution formula reflects the original intent of the LATCF to support counties with federal lands within their jurisdiction. Frame the benefits of payment technology to attract adoption

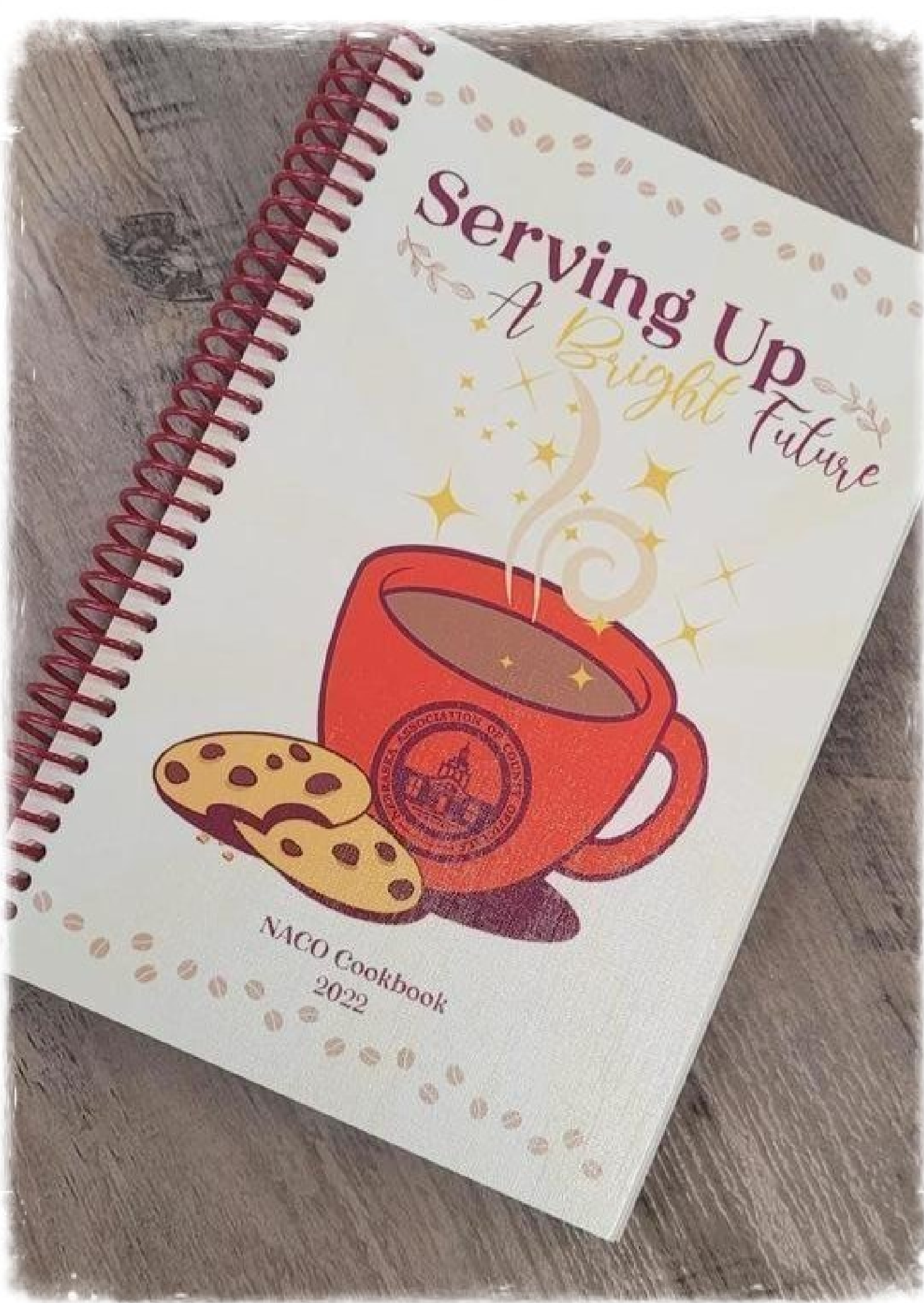
