Updated Open Meetings Act Poster

The most recently concluded legislative session included an update to the Open Meetings Act which was effective immediately. NACO strongly advises downloading

this copy (<u>link</u>) of the current Act and having it posted in any chamber in which a meeting is held.

A copy of the Open Meetings Act, as amended by LB287, section 74, is linked and provided at the <u>NACO website</u> at Resources, Other Resources, Meetings, Open Meetings Act (effective 4/17/2024). Until the poster is completed and in effect, the prior mentioned Open Meetings Act will suffice for the requirement provided in 84-1412(8), "Public bodies shall make available at least one current copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the meeting room at a location accessible to members of the public. At the beginning of the meeting, the public shall be informed about the location of the posted information."

NACO will provide each county with one free poster that can be posted in a county's meeting room to fulfill the requirements of the Act referenced above, including shipping and handling. Additional posters can be ordered to be shipped along with your county's free poster until July 8th.

Overtime Final Rule Issued

On April 23, 2024, the U.S. Department of Labor (Department) announced a final rule, <u>Defining and Delimiting the Exemptions for Executive, Administrative, Professional, Outside Sales, and Computer Employees</u>, which will take effect on July 1, 2024. The final rule updates and revises the regulations issued under section 13(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act implementing the exemption from minimum wage and overtime pay requirements for executive, administrative, and professional (EAP) employees. Revisions include increases to the standard salary level and the highly compensated employee total annual compensation threshold, and a mechanism that provides for the timely and efficient updating of these earnings thresholds to reflect current earnings data. Employees of public agencies, such as counties, are covered in some circumstances.


- Use Strong Passwords or Biometric Authentication
