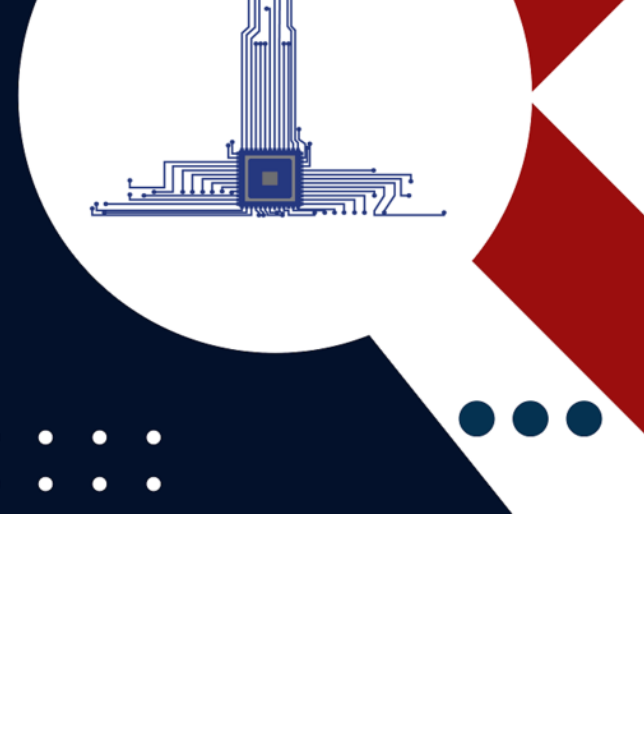
NEBRASKA CYBERSECURITY PLANNING COMMITTEE

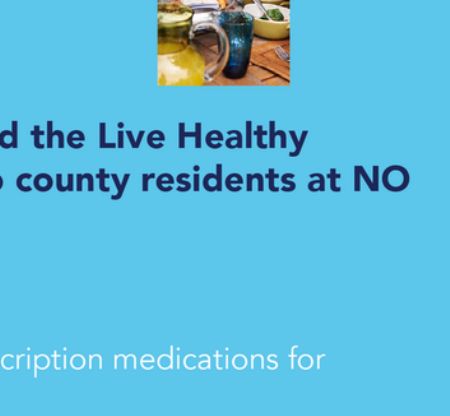
