

Broadband Equity Access and Deployment (BEAD) Toolkit

NACo's new <u>BEAD toolkit</u> will guide counties through broadband funding and deployment strategies.

About the BEAD Program: The <u>Broadband Equity Access and Deployment (BEAD)</u> <u>program</u> earmarks over \$42 billion for the expansion of high-speed internet to locations without adequate service.

Toolkit for counties: NACo's toolkit offers <u>resources and information</u> for county leaders, including guidance in navigating the state challenge process to prioritize areas for broadband investment.

Don Harpst Sr. Leadership Nebraska Award

Nebraska Press Association has revamped one of its annual awards in hopes of it becoming one of the most highly coveted honors among Nebraska community newspapers.

It is the Don Harpst Sr. Leadership Nebraska Award -- established by the Harpst family to encourage and reward leadership by newspaper publishers or employees in the communities they serve.

One of the key changes made is to seek nominations from outside of the Nebraska newspaper industry. It is the local people, the local elected officials who know best if someone from their local newspaper is deserving of the award. Also, the annual award will now come with a \$1,500 grant with those proceeds to be gifted back into one or more community organizations of the recipient's choice.

Nebraska Broadband Office Invites Comment on Initial Proposal Volume 2

The Nebraska Broadband Office (NBO) is moving to the next phase of efforts to ensure access for all Nebraskans to reliable broadband.

As part of this effort, there will be ongoing public engagements across the state including a series of nine public meetings and an open comment period from Nov. 13 to Dec. 13. During the open comment period the public will be asked to provide comments on NBO's long-term goals and objectives to deploy broadband and plans to coordinate with local representatives. Meetings and comments will also focus on NBO's plan to ensure that an equitable and highly-skilled workforce is utilized throughout the buildout process, the subgrant process and NBO's low cost affordable and middle-income plans.
