# Nebraska Broadband Office Invites Comment on Initial Proposal Volume 2

The Nebraska Broadband Office (NBO) is moving to the next phase of efforts to ensure access for all Nebraskans to reliable broadband.

As part of this effort, there will be ongoing public engagements across the state including a series of nine public meetings and an open comment period from Nov. 13 to Dec. 13. During the open comment period the public will be asked to provide comments on NBO's long-term

goals and objectives to deploy broadband and plans to coordinate with local representatives. Meetings and comments will also focus on NBO's plan to ensure that an equitable and highly-skilled workforce is utilized throughout the buildout process, the subgrant process and NBO's low cost affordable and middle-income plans.


