- City Of Neligh Police Department
- Police Car Computers & Radios
- Funded in 2020-Completed in 2021
- Community Facilities Grant Program \$38,200 grant
- Brought City in compliance with a recent Nebraska Supreme Court revised rule amendment for citations.
 - Mandatory transition from paper to electronic citations unless prior approval was granted by State Court Administrator.

Village of Cook Water Tower Repair



- Village of Cook
- Water Tower Repair Project
- Funded and Completed in 2014
- Emergency Community Water Assistance Grant - \$134,490
- Repaired a leaking water tower that had to be taken offline for a time.
 - Before that, the Village was experiencing a significant decline in their quantity of water.

Additional Opportunities: Housing

• SINGLE FAMILY HOUSING

- Loans: Single Family Housing Home Purchase Loans
 - No down payment
 - 100% affordable fixed rate financing
 - Closing costs and repairs may be included
 - Income guidelines apply
- Grants: Housing Preservation
 - Grants help rural residents repair, improve, or modernize their homes
 - Up to \$10,000 for health and safety repairs
 - Available to low income seniors

Additional Opportunities: Business

BUSINESS PROGRAMS

- Value Added Producer Grants:
 - The Value-Added Producer Grant (VAPG) program helps agricultural producers enter into value-added activities related to the processing and marketing of new products. The goals of this program are to generate new products, create and expand marketing opportunities and increase producer income.
- Business and Industry Loan Guarantees:
 - This program offers loan guarantees to lenders for their loans to rural businesses.
- Energy Programs:
 - Our programs, authorized by the Agricultural Act of 2014, offer funding to complete energy audits, provide renewable energy development assistance, make energy efficiency improvements and install renewable energy systems.
- Rural Business Development Grants:
 - This program is designed to provide technical assistance and training for small rural businesses. Small means that the business has fewer than 50 new workers and less than \$1 million in gross revenue.
