NACo - Federal Government Shutdown: What Counties Need to Know

As of 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, October 1, federal appropriations have lapsed, leading to a shutdown of government operations and agencies. This shutdown occurred because the 12 appropriations bills that fund federal agencies were not passed by Congress and signed by the president by the end of the fiscal year, which concluded on Sept. 30.

Continuous, predictable federal funding is crucial for counties as intergovernmental partners. While county governments generate over two-thirds of our own revenue to provide services to residents, counties receive \$62 billion in intergovernmental revenue from the federal government.

Legislative Interim Studies Scheduled

Unfunded mandates on counties ([LR195](#)), publication of meeting notices ([LR192](#)), and valuation of ethanol plants ([LR118](#)) will be the subject of legislative interim study hearings on October 3.

Other hearings in October will focus on county initiatives and referendums ([LR253](#)), riparian weed control funding ([LR168](#)), and affordable housing ([LR86](#)). A full list of hearing dates and locations can be found [here](#).

Interim study resolutions are introduced during the regular legislative session to study issues following the adjournment. They provide an opportunity for a deeper dive into bills that were introduced during prior sessions, and some focus on ideas for bills to be introduced in 2026. Some hearings are limited to invited testimony, but public comments are accepted through the online comment button for each resolution. Some hearings will be livestreamed through [Nebraska Public Media](#).

State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program

The [State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program](#) (SLCGP) aims to help states, local governments, rural areas, and communities address cybersecurity risks and threats to data, networks, and information systems. Through strategic stakeholder engagement, SLCGP hopes to implement cyber governance and planning. Increase assessment and evaluation capabilities, prioritize identified cyber risks, and help to address cyber workforce deltas. This will improve the security of government, critical infrastructure, systems, and services that Nebraskans rely on.

Create a Savi Account for Free Student Loan Repayment Guidance

What Borrowers Need to Know:

- As of August 1, 2025, student loan interest began accruing again for the nearly 8 million borrowers enrolled in the Saving on a Valuable Education (SAVE) Plan.
- The future of the SAVE Plan remains uncertain. In the meantime, interest is now being added to loan balances, though forbearances that pause payments remain in effect.
- While no immediate action is required, borrowers looking to avoid accumulating interest may want to switch to an active repayment plan. You can explore your options and [enroll directly through your Savi account.](#)

Elite Business Member Spotlight: Nebraska Regional Interoperability Network (NRIN)

LOCALLY OWNED NETWORK

From Chadron to Nebraska City, responders have access to a locally-owned network, designed to improve interoperable communications across Nebraska. Work on the Nebraska Regional Interoperability Network (NRIN) links most of the State's Public Service Answering Points (PSAPs). Local responders can now use statewide communication resources and new, developing technologies through the transport capabilities that NRIN offers. Local ownership ensures the network is responsive to community needs.

RELIABLE & SECURE

NRIN is a point-to-point IP-based microwave network capable of moving data as fast as 100 megabytes per second, and it runs at 5(9s) capability, meaning that 99.999 percent of the time, there is a redundant connection available. The network can transport large amounts of data, radio, voice, and video quickly and efficiently in a secure and reliable fashion. The many circles that are being created are for redundancy. This network cannot be used for any kind of direct connection to the internet, safeguarding against cybersecurity threats.

LOCAL-STATE PARTNERSHIP

Local communities can use it in a variety of ways, including as a primary 911 system, like in the East Central Region and Beatrice, or with an 800 MHz system to enhance the connections with local law enforcement and volunteer fire departments. In Cass County and the city of Madison, the NRIN connection is used to provide remote siren capability. Counties also use the connection for the Statewide Radio System (SRS), Computer Assisted Dispatch (CAD), and for booking systems. NRIN is run by a Board of Directors that includes 911 Directors, Emergency Managers, and other stakeholders interested in the safety of Nebraska communities. NRIN is located on more than 250 sites and is used by 30 public agencies across the state.
