Legislative Interim Studies Scheduled

This afternoon the Legislature's Transportation and Telecommunications Committee will hear about broadband expansion projects and funding during an interim hearing on <u>LR402</u>. The hearing will begin at 1:30 p.m. (Central) and will be livestreamed on <u>Nebraska Public Media</u>.

Upcoming hearings will focus on emergency medical services in rural communities (<u>LR428</u> – Oct. 30) and an annual examination of the Nebraska Public Employees Retirement Systems (<u>LR408</u> – Nov. 22), as well as other education, health and human services, transportation and agriculture issues. Hearings on inheritance taxes (<u>LR314</u>) and unfunded mandates (<u>LR435</u>) are expected to be scheduled next month. A full list of hearing dates can be found here.

Interim study resolutions are introduced during the regular legislative session to study issues following the adjournment of the legislative session. Ideas generated from the studies are often introduced as legislation in the following session.

LB1204 Local Tobacco License Report

<u>LB 1204</u> passed earlier this year now requires county clerks to report to the Nebraska Department of Revenue (DOR) the notification of granting a local tobacco license.

The initial report from the counties for 2025 will be due January 31, 2025.

This report must be filed even if the county has no tobacco licensees. Nebraska Department of Revenue is in the process of finalizing the reporting method. It will be done either through the electronic document and application hub (eDASH) or DOR's secure file sharing system.

CYBER SECURITY KEYPOINTS

Beware of Public Wi-Fi for Sensitive Tasks

When using public Wi-Fi, avoid accessing sensitive accounts or sharing personal information. Hackers can easily intercept data over unsecured connections. Use a Virtual Private Network (VPN) to keep your internet activity secure.



Check for HTTPS on Web sites

When entering sensitive information online, always ensure the website starts with https://. This means the site is encrypted, protecting your data from being intercepted by hackers.



Verify Unexpected Password Reset Requests

If you receive an email prompting you to reset your password for an account you didn't request, be cautious. Social engineers might be trying to gain access. Always initiate password resets directly from the website, not through email links.

Fake Security Alerts

Beware of urgent "security alerts" claiming that your account has been compromised. These phishing emails often direct you to fake login pages to steal your credentials. Always visit websites directly rather than clicking on links in emails.




